# **GENERAL REGULATIONS**

Please read the rules and guidelines carefully and consult the rules related to specific classes in the list.

#### **EXHIBIT ENTRIES**

- 1. An entry fee of \$1 per item shall apply. Entry fee can be paid by etransfer to the Vegreville Cultural Association at <a href="mailto:info@pysankafestival.com">info@pysankafestival.com</a> or in person (cash or cheque) at the Vegreville Cultural Association office, 4737-45 Avenue, Vegreville. Call 780-632-2777 to make in-person arrangements. If paying by etransfer ensure comments state: Folk Art Entry ENTRANT'S NAME.
- 2. One entry form per exhibitor is to be completed (ie: different exhibitors cannot share the same form).
- 3. Only one entry per exhibitor in each class or sub-class is permitted.
- 4. The item(s) submitted for judging must be created by the exhibitor.
- 5. Items entered in previous years are not eligible for entry again.
- 6. Entry Forms & payment must be received no later than June 28, 2024.

- 7. Entries close at 11:59 pm MST sharp on June 28, 2024.
- 8. Entry tags MUST be securely attached by the exhibitor. Fastening supplies to be provided by exhibitor.
  - a. Entry tags can be picked up in advance from the Vegreville Cultural Association office (call 780-632-2777 to make arrangements) or at the time of exhibit drop off.
  - b. Please complete the tag information and bend the bottom portion to cover your name.
  - c. Tags must remain attached to exhibits during the show.
- 9. Exhibits must be brought to the Exhibit Building (Vegreville Fair Grounds, south side near the Grandstand (red star on map)) on Thursday, July 4, 2024, between 3:00 pm and 8:00 pm. Out-of-town entries will be accepted on Friday, July 5, 2024 morning, with prior arrangement through <a href="mailto:PysankaFolkArts@hotmail.com">PysankaFolkArts@hotmail.com</a>.



- 10. Exhibitors will not be permitted into the Exhibit Hall while judging is in progress, except for Association Directors and volunteers.
- 11. Exhibits must be picked up between 3:00 pm and 5:00 pm on Sunday, July 7, 2024; special cases to be discussed with the Folk Arts coordinator. Exhibits not picked up by 5:00 pm on Sunday, July 7, 2024, will become property of the Vegreville Cultural Association.

#### **JUDGING AND AWARDING PRIZES**

- 1. Judges' decisions are final. Exhibitors wishing to lodge a protest can do so in writing and must be delivered to the Folk Arts Coordinator within 48 hours of the close of the Vegreville Pysanka Festival. Protests must be accompanied by a deposit of \$75 which will be forfeited to the Association if the protest is not sustained.
- 2. Judges can withhold prizes should an exhibit not be deemed worthy even if there is no competition.
- 3. Prizes of 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> may be awarded by Judges where no exhibit is up to standards to receive 1<sup>st</sup>.
- 4. Exhibits entered in incorrect age categories will be disqualified.
