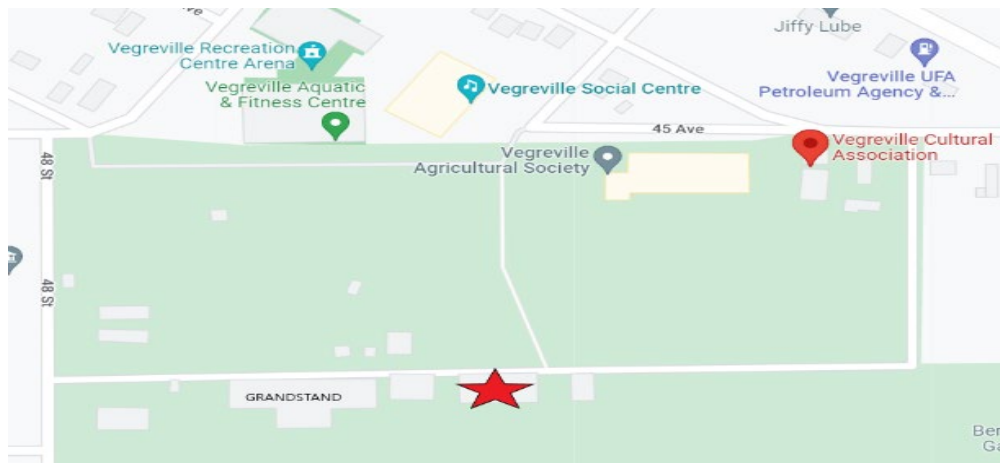


GENERAL REGULATIONS

Please read the rules and guidelines carefully and consult the rules related to specific classes in the list.

EXHIBIT ENTRIES

1. An entry fee of \$1 per item shall apply. Entry fee can be paid by etransfer to the Vegreville Cultural Association Treasurer at orestolineck@yahoo.ca or in person (cash only) at the Vegreville Cultural Association office. Call 780-632-2777 to make in person arrangements. If paying by etransfer ensure comments state: Folk Art Entry – *ENTRANT'S NAME*.
2. One entry form per exhibitor is to be completed (ie: different exhibitors cannot share the same form).
3. Only one entry per exhibitor in each class or sub-class permitted.
4. The item(s) submitted for judging must be created by the exhibitor.
5. Entry Forms & payment must be received no later than June 30, 2023.
 - a. Entry Forms can be submitted to: PysankaFolkArts@hotmail.com or in person at the Vegreville Cultural Association office. Call 780-632-2777 to make in person arrangements.
6. Entries close at 11:59 pm MST sharp on June 30, 2023.
7. Entry tags MUST be securely attached by the exhibitor. Fastening supplies to be provided by exhibitor.
 - a. Entry tags can be picked up in advance from the Vegreville Cultural Association office (call 780-632-2777 to make arrangements) or at time of exhibit drop off on July 6, 2023.
 - b. Please complete the tag information and bend the bottom portion to cover your name.
 - c. Tags must remain attached to exhibits during the show.
8. Exhibits must be brought to the Exhibit Building (Vegreville Fair Grounds, south side near the Grandstand (red star on map)) on July 6, 2023, between 3:00 pm and 8:00 pm. No exhibits will be accepted after 8:00 pm on July 6, 2023.



9. Exhibitors will not be permitted into the Exhibit Hall while judging is in progress, with the exception of Association Directors and volunteers.
10. Exhibits must be picked up between 2:00 pm and 5:00 pm on Sunday, July 9, 2023. Exhibits not picked up by 5:00 pm on Sunday, July 9, 2023, will become property of the Vegreville Cultural Association.

JUDGING AND AWARDING PRIZES

1. Judges' decisions are final. Exhibitors wishing to lodge a protest can do so in writing and must be delivered to the Folk Arts Coordinator within 48 hours of the close of the Vegreville Pysanka Festival. Protests must be accompanied by a deposit of \$75 which will be forfeited to the Association if the protest is not sustained.
2. Judges can withhold prizes should an exhibit not be deemed worthy even if there is no competition.
3. Prizes of 2nd or 3rd may be awarded by Judges where no exhibit is up to standards to receive 1st.
4. Exhibits entered in incorrect age categories will be disqualified.

COMPETITION CATEGORIES AND GENERAL RULES

SECTION A – HANDICRAFTS

Entries must be the work of the exhibitor in 2022-2023. The exhibitor may enter only one item per class. Embroidery must be of traditional Ukrainian design and color using counted thread method. Entry form and tag must include design style/region displayed on the item.

ADULT CLASS 1 – EMBROIDERY (Cross-stitch, Nyzynka, Yavorivka, etc.)

SECTION B – HOBBYCRAFTS

Entries must be the work of the exhibitor completed in 2022-2023. The exhibitor may enter only one item per class. Designs should be based on traditional motifs and colors. Judged on artistic creation and execution of design. Entry form and tag must include the design style/region displayed on the item.

SECTION C – TRADITIONAL UKRAINIAN BAKING

Entries must be the work of the exhibitor. The exhibitor may enter only one item per class. Baking to be displayed in clear plastic bags (exception: Korovai), otherwise item will be disqualified. **Baking must be brought to the Exhibit Building by 8:00 am on July 7, 2023.** All classes will be judged based on presentation and taste. Exception: Korovai judged on presentation only.
